**About the speaker:**

Dr. Theodor Waigel was the German finance minister from 1989 to 1998. In the years 1988 to 1999 he was also the chairman of the CSU. After his university studies in law and political science in Munich and Würzburg, he started his career in the Bavarian administration. From 1972 to 2002 he was a member of the German Parliament and in the years 1982 to 1989 he was the chairman of the CSU parliamentary group. After leaving his active political career, he has been holding various high-profile board positions (including Unicredit SpA) and he still acts as the Compliance Monitor at Siemens AG. Today he also works as an attorney-at-law in Munich and he is honorary chairman of the CSU.
